(Somerset, NJ) - On Friday, July 31 2015 at approximately 21:40 hours, Kyle Scheuerman left the Millstone Valley Fire Department on a motorcycle. After not returning within a few minutes, several members began a local search for him until the early morning hours of August 1, 2015. As the search resumed in the later morning of the 1st, we received notification that a single motorcyclist was found down on Millstone River Rd. This motorcyclist was later identified as missing firefighter Kyle Scheuerman.

Our department would like to express our sincere gratitude for all those that have reached out to us and the Scheuerman family during this difficult time. As we prepare to remember Kyle, we're providing the service details below for all those who would like to join us. I have also identified several areas that we could use some assistance.
